Monitors inventory of all maintenance equipment and the use of the equipment, preventative maintenance schedule, and safety training

Works closely with Superintendent in managing annual budget and maintenance recordkeeping

Works closely with Superintendent in preparing short-term and long-term agronomic strategies for maintenance of the golf course daily, weekly, monthly and yearly fertilization, irrigation, etc. schedules

Calibrates and operates pesticide sprayers

Perform related duties as assigned by supervisor or manager

Irrigation repair and scheduling will be carried out as needed

Ability to work long hours when necessary (possibly with little notice)

Must be able to work weekends and holidays
