



# MAGCS Match Play Championship

## Condition of Play

Play is governed by the Rules of Golf as approved by the USGA and R&A. Published local rules are to be followed (please consult facility if in question).

Competitors are responsible for setting up time and location to play their match. Match may be either 9 or 18 holes as agreed upon by competitors before play commences. Competitors are encouraged to play with other members that are competing in the event.

Handicap Indexes issued by an authorized golf club or Authorized Golf Association are to be converted to Course Handicap based upon the tees being used. If a golfer does not have an established Handicap Index from an authorized golf club or Authorized Golf Association, they must compete as a scratch golfer with a Course Handicap of 0.

Distance measuring devices are allowed as long as they don't measure other conditions such as elevation changes, wind speed and the like.

Once completed, please email MAGCS the outcome of the match or if so inclined, tweet it out and include us in it @MidwestAGCS. If you don't complete your match by declared date, a coin flip, conducted by the MAGCS will determine the winner to advance the event. If no effort was made by a particular player to complete the match before the deadline, the opposing player will be awarded the victory without a coin toss.
