Medinah Country Club was designed on 550 acres by Tom Bendelow in 1924. It is comprised of 54 holes: Course 1 was redesigned by Tom Doak in 2012, Course 2 was reconstructed to bring back Tom Bendelow's original design intent in 2017, and the championship Course 3 is currently under reconstruction by Australian architecture firm OCM. https://www.ocm.golf/

Course 3, a Top 100 club, has been the site of 6 Major Championships and will host the **2026 President's Cup**.
