Position Summary:

The Glen Club is looking for a Mechanic to manage the golf maintenance assets, including the equipment and maintenance shop. Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Safely operate equipment and accessories as trained and assigned including, but not limited to, greens mowers, rotary mowers, tri-plex mowers, vertical mowers, line trimmers, edgers, utility vehicles, back-pack blowers, portable pumps, aerifiers, spikers, mechanical top dressers, sod cutters, mechanical bunker rakes, tractors, sweepers, blades, loaders, backhoes, trenchers, chain saws, and miscellaneous hand tools.
- Plan, supervise and execute the tasks of maintaining all the turf specific equipment, specialized equipment, and heavy equipment.
